We have divided the program into several sessions of what we are calling "Program Specific Activities" in which campers can participate in activities directly associated with Architecture, Construction Science, Landscape Architecture and Urban Planning or Visualization. The campers will sign up for the program that they are most interested in learning more about and during those "Program Specific Activities" the campers will be divided up into smaller groups of Architecture, Construction Science, Landscape Architecture and Urban Planning and Visualization and take classes in those specific areas. The program is limited to 60 participants. Students will be selected based on academic achievement and essay response.

We do offer scholarships for students who need financial assistance. Please look on the application instructions for details. Cost for camp is \$700.

Once you have been notified of your acceptance into the program, you will be required to pay the \$700 camp fee. Instructions on how to do so will be included in your acceptance letter.
